

NEWS FROM YOUR PARISH COUNCIL

Finger Post – Coldharbour Corner

Following the Council's appeal in the last issue of Cledry Calling, and with the support of the Church Wardens and the Gilbert Hall Trustees in publicising the fundraising, the Council are delighted to say that a total of £483.00 has been raised towards the cost of repairing the fingerpost. This came from individual donations, a cake stall held at the School and a Coffee morning held by the Gilbert Hall Trustees and the Council are very grateful to everyone that donated and fundraised. As a result the Council have instructed Iron Brothers to go ahead with the repair. The total cost of the repair is £790 & VAT and the Council had agreed to match fund and pay half the repairs. Thanks to everyone's generosity this means that the Council have had to pay £88 less than they had expected. They have resolved to spend this amount saved on something that will benefit the community as a whole potentially at Christmas time, exact details to be confirmed in due course.

Highways

The Council are continually reporting any issues that are brought to their attention regarding the state of the roads in the Parish. Meetings

The Council welcomes all residents to the monthly Parish Council meetings. There is a 15 minute period near the start of the meeting, which is set aside specifically so that residents can voice any concerns they have on any parish matter. After this period they may choose to leave, or stay and listen to (but not join in) council deliberations. The Parish Council needs to know residents views on parish matters to enable it to make balanced judgements and sound decisions on the important matters that affect our community. The Parish Council usually meets on the last Tuesday in the month at 7.00pm (exceptions to this are December). The meeting dates for the next three months are: 26th June, 24th July and 28th August, subject to confirmation at the Annual meeting being held on 29th May. Agendas for and minutes from all meetings are published on the Parish Noticeboard and the Parish Council website.
