Finger Post – Coldharbour Corner

As most of you will be aware sadly sometime between Christmas and New Year the recently restored fingerpost at Coldharbour Corner had one of its fingers ripped off. Due to the nature of the damage it looks like this must have been done deliberately. The matter has been reported to the Police but unsurprisingly, as there were no witnesses, they are unable to pursue it any further. The Council do not want to leave it in this state, having spent nearly £1,400 on its restoration. However to repair the finger and replace it is going to cost £790. Initially the Council had planned to set up a Crowdfunding page, but a number of people have already pledged to support this project, and intend to do individual fundraising. It therefore seems sensible that, rather than pay the 8% fees that Crowdfunding charge, anyone who wishes to donate sends their cheques, made payable to Towednack Parish Council, direct to the Clerk at 19 Primrose Lane, Goldsithney, Penzance TR20 9LX. If the Parish can raise £395 between them then the Council will match fund this and the repairs can go ahead. The Clerk will update the total raised regularly via the Nancledra Facebook page. Car Parking in Nancledra

In the previous edition of Cledry Meadow the Council asked for your help regarding parking in Nancledra. Unfortunately as only two people responded, and one other requested a permit should they become available, the Council made the decision at their January meeting that they would not be taking any further action, due to the lack of interest from the Parish. However, the issue of access to Cledry Meadow is still a problem as people are parking in front of the lock posts. The Council will therefore be moving these further out to ensure access to the Meadow for all that wish to use it. The Council would also like to add that, whilst they feel they have no mandate to take any further action regarding trying to help with the parking, it would help if residents themselves could show a little consideration to their neighbours by not using parking spaces when they have room to park at home, parking as considerately as possible to allow the maximum no of cars space to park and be aware that there is no overnight camping permitted and that should this practice continue action may be taken.

Meetings

The Parish Council welcomes all residents to the monthly Parish Council meetings. There is a 15 minute period, at the start of each meeting, which is set aside specifically so that residents can voice any concerns they have on any parish matter. After this period they may choose to leave, or stay and listen to (but not join in) council deliberations. The Parish Council needs to know residents views on parish matters to enable it to make balanced judgements and sound decisions on the important matters that affect our community. The Parish Council usually meets on the last Tuesday in the month at 7.00pm (exceptions to this are December). The meeting dates for the next three months are: 27th March, 24th April and 29th May. Please note the AGM will be held prior to the meeting on 29th May, commencing at 6.30pm. Agendas for and minutes from all meetings are published on the Parish Noticeboard and the Parish Council website.
