### **Public Consultation re Affordable Homes in Nancladra**

Recently the Nancladra Housing Working Party and the Cornwall Community Land Trust held a public consultation at the Gilbert Hall, with the intention of shortly submitting a planning application for nine houses at the 'White Croft' site in Nancladra. The Parish Council will be considering this application when it comes before it, and would encourage everyone to let them know their thoughts before a decision is made.

### **Finger Post – Coldharbour Corner**

To update everyone who may be wondering why work has not yet been completed on repairing the fingerpost, the Parish Council are looking to see if they can move the fingerpost inwards slightly away from the road, to hopefully avoid any future damage to the post, before the work is actually undertaken. This should be sorted soon and the repair work to the fingerpost will then be completed.

### **Highways**

The Council are continually reporting any issues that are brought to their attention regarding the state of the roads in the Parish. Please note that anyone can report an issue that they spot, e.g. a large pothole, via the Cornwall Council website using the following link: <https://www.cornwall.gov.uk/transport-and-streets/roads-highways-and-pavements/highway-maintenance/potholes/report-a-pothole>. By using this link you can then see if the issue has been reported previously, and any repairs carried out in the last 24 hours.

### **Cledry Meadow**

The Parish Council has been delighted to see events taking place in Cledry Meadow again in July, namely a Summer Fete and an Open Air Songs of Praise with St Erth Band, both organised by Towednack Parish Church.

### **Meetings**

The Council welcomes all residents to the monthly Parish Council meetings. There is a 15 minute period near the start of the meeting, which is set aside specifically so that residents can voice any concerns they have on any parish matter. After this period they may choose to leave, or stay and listen to (but not join in) council deliberations. The Parish Council needs to know residents views on parish matters to enable it to make balanced judgements and sound decisions on the important matters that affect our community. The Parish Council usually meets on the last Tuesday in the month at 7.00pm (exceptions to this are December). The meeting dates for the next four months are: 25<sup>th</sup> September, 30<sup>th</sup> October, 27<sup>th</sup> November and 18<sup>th</sup> December. Agendas for and minutes from all meetings are published on the Parish Noticeboard and the Parish Council website.
